The plan also provides for a family pastor at Ryde, which has been a long felt need. Our council has really put in the time and effort so that we can see WIC flourish.

Melissa and I want to share with you that we feel a strong calling from God to step out in faith and lead the Wesley Western Sydney church plant next year.

We have shared this with the elders who have affirmed and been supportive of this call. It is also part of the fulfillment of the Wesley Mission vision of "A Spiritled disciple making movement planting" churches and missional communities across NSW.

We believe that this is a God-ordained new season for our entire church family and that God is going to do significant and powerful things amongst us and through us through these changes. At the same time we know these are significant and difficult changes to process.
